The Event:

This year we will be conducting a weekend-long event of horseback riding, camping, and fun to raise money for St. Jude hospital. We will gather at the ranch on Friday to register and you can explore the ranch and land on your own. On Saturday morning, we will begin a 4 hour trail ride at 11am. We will stop for a pack lunch and have our benefit spaghetti dinner at the ranch that evening. Sunday morning we will again head out for a pack lunch trail ride.

The fee per person for the weekend package is \$50/person or \$90/couple, using your own horse(s). Primitive camping sites are available free of charge. If you would like to upgrade to an electrical hookup site, there is a small fee of \$10/ rig. If you are only able to join us for one ride, the fee will be \$30/person or \$50/couple. The ranch will be donating a portion of these fees back to St. Jude Hospital. **All money you raise from your sponsors will go directly to St. Jude.**

St. Jude is the **only pediatric cancer research center where families pay for treatments that are not covered by insurance and NO CHILD IS EVER DENIED TREATMENT DUE TO THE FAMILY'S INABILITY TO PAY.**

St. Jude has treated children from all 50 states and all around the world. The **daily operating cost is \$1.3 million**, which is primarily **covered by public contributions.**

During the past three years, **85.3 percent of every dollar received** by St. Jude has gone to the current and future needs of the hospital.
